

COVID Safe Event Attendance Guidelines:

The VCCC Alliance is committed to maintaining the highest COVID safe standards for our in-person and hybrid events and meetings ('events'). These standards are particularly important for events hosted in the Victorian Comprehensive Cancer Centre building to ensure we continue to protect patients with cancer, their families and medical staff who are moving through the same building.

At 25 May 2022: if you are a visitor or alliance member colleague housed externally to the building ('visitor') and you are registered to attend a VCCC Alliance event in person, the following COVID safe procedures apply:

Before attending any event in person

- If you have any COVID-19 symptoms, feel unwell, or have been a household or social contact with a COVID-19 positive case within the past 7 days, please contact the event organiser to have your attendance changed to an online invitation.

When attending the Victorian Comprehensive Cancer Centre in person

- All visitors are required to be **fully vaccinated (at least two doses)** against COVID-19 and will be asked to show proof of vaccination on entry
- **Unvaccinated visitors** will be required to complete a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT), provided on arrival, and will only be able to access the building if the result is negative (please allow at least 15 mins prior to attain result)
- All visitors are required to complete an **online attestation** before entering the Victorian Comprehensive Cancer Centre. '**Contractors**' is the most appropriate category to select for your attestation from the categories available
- All visitors must wear a facial mask at all times while in the building unless eating or drinking. A **surgical or N95 mask will be provided** on entry
- All visitors are asked to **limit movement** around the building to the organised event area and public facilities such as toilets and cafes
- All visitors are asked to maintain **social distancing** (1.5mts) and regular **hand hygiene**

When attending a VCCC Alliance event at another venue

- Participants are required to be **fully vaccinated (at least two doses)** against COVID-19
- Participants are strongly encouraged to wear an **N95 or surgical mask** unless eating or drinking
- Maintain **social distancing (1.5mt)** and **density limits** per venue requirements
- **Maintain hand hygiene**, supplies will be made available at all VCCC Alliance run events

After attending an event

- If you **test positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours** of attending a VCCC Alliance event in person, please contact the organiser as soon as possible who will take discrete steps to notify attendees to watch for symptoms.
